Year in Review

2018 Season in Revue Idylwylde G & CC Turf Department

Once again our greatest challenge continues to be the health of greens coming out of winter. Over 16000ft² of putting surface required repair, approximately 11000 ft² was repaired with sod. The remainder was seeded using a series of techniques that we have improved upon year after year. Over 1500 individual plugs of turf from our nursery were used to aid in recovery. While we started with six temporary greens in less than 30 days from when we started the recovery process all greens were in play by May 26th.

This obviously consumed a great deal of our resources in the spring so we didn't get the head start that we had planned for improving the greens surrounds. However throughout the course of the season 350lbs of seed was applied to the green surrounds. By that time though we had entered one of the warmest and direst stretches of weather in recent memory which isn't the greatest of conditions for seed survival. Our newly installed irrigation in the greens complexes sure was able to be showcased though. By the end of the season we used 17.7 million gallons of water to irrigate the golf course. The weather continued to dominate on course activities as half way through September and October total rainfall was the most I've seen during my time with the club. In a stretch of 15 days we saw over 5" of rainfall. Even as I write this we are pushing to install the tarps before a forecasted early winter snow storm. Bottom line the weather plays such a critical role in all aspects of our operation but with that being said we continued to compile a solid list of yearly improvements.

- 875' of drainage installed throughout the golf course
- 80 Tonne of bunker sand added to sand traps
- 9600 ft² of Kentucky blue grass sod laid
- 9 green complexes old irrigation sprinklers and valves removed
- Right side of 3 green complex renovated
- Connected fairway to green on hole 5
- Filled high impact area of ditch and re grassed on hole 6
- Rebuilt front right sand trap on hole 10
- Contoured back right sand trap on hole 10
- Improved landing area front left of 12 green complex including re building the sand trap
- Installed single head control sprinklers on holes 10,11,12,13 to improve turf conditions
- Bag drop area interlock pad created
- Improved cart washing area by installing catch basing and surface drainage improvements
- New driving range mat system installed and ready for spring grand opening
- Turf Care Center Renovations and Maintenance
- Re-furbishing of course hardware i.e. Tee blocks, Garbage cans, ball washers, signage etc.
- Preventative maintenance and repairs of all equipment
- Maintained Level 2 IPM accreditation through submission of the annual report and holding a public meeting to present
- Audubon Water Conservation category fulfilled. One more to go. Outreach and Education
- Goose "Kill to scare" permit obtained and goose control through egg oiling and addling, as well 7 kill to scare
- Greens aeration
- Vented and top dressed putting surfaces bi weekly
- Vertidrained all putting surfaces before winter
- Winter walking trails maintained

Year in Review

The Idylwylde Golf & Country Club is pleased to share the accomplishments that we have experienced over the past year. It is very important for us to continue to improve and make changes for our members and prospective members. We look forward to achieving even more next year!

- Irrigation System added that allows us to control watering to the greens and surrounds separately which has made a huge difference already.
- New website built that is more user friendly and will make managing the site much easier.
- Changed the newsletter format that also links to the website and has more analytics.
- Created an Idylwylde app for both golf and curling.
- Purchased an Ice Maker's Mistress to add to curling plant room the will see the club realize about 40%+ savings in hydro and gas usage in the curling rink.
- Changed menu costing to ensure more adequate meal portions at a fair price.
- Change tournament bag drop area to better serve our guests on tournament days.
- Changed our tournament staging area to better facilitate our events, with this came the adding
 of more speakers to our PA system outside.
- Started a strong time par campaign to help pace of play with positive results.
- Started a <u>year round</u> men's league scoring format with a year-end final shotgun.
- Added a gift card module to our current POS system to give us more flexibility with prizing and allow us to sell gift cards.
- Added a play with a pro day on Fridays.
- Global/Card program implemented for our payables. The club eliminated having to write a lot
 of cheques and saved on postage from paying suppliers directly with a one-time use credit card
 through the system. The club also received \$737 in rebates from 6 months on the program.
- Began paying employees gratuities via direct deposit.
- New payroll system added eliminating time and keying errors due to direct upload from clock in system. It also automatically calculates statutory holiday pay. The system runs about the same price as the prior one but saves on time.
- Savings were seen in wages as the club hired a part-time assistant in the office instead of fulltime and at a lower wage than the previous. The extra work is being absorbed by the salaried positions in the office.
- New marketing role added that will see us keep our website up to date and communications with the membership improve.


